As READERS we will be:

Clarifying new words, making predictions and summarising what we have read. We will also be asking and answering questions about our reading. We will continue to learn and apply our

As WRITERS we will be:

Acquiring new vocabulary and using this effectively in our writing, learning to spell words from the 1/2 word lists and building on the range of punctuation that we can use accurately. We will be doing this in a range of contexts.

In fiction we will be exploring how stories are structured, character development, sequence and the children will write their own stories based on Oliver's Vegetables and Mr Percy's Magic Greenhouse.

As MATHEMATICIANS we will be:

First we are focusing on place value and counting up to 100. We will use various strategies and equipment to become confident in simple calculation using the four operations. We will also be developing our 2x 5x 10x tables and applying this real life situations .

As HISTORIANS we will be:

Researching historical facts about the past using a range of resources . We will be looking at our own school life and comparing this with Victorian life at Stepney.

As Artists we will be look a range of artists famous for portrait art. We will make a series of work in similar styles.

In PE we will be: developing a range of skills that improve, balance, agility and coordination.

In RE Year 1 doing the unit called Looking at Me.
Year 2 will be doing the unit called Belonging.

Following the Jigsaw Unit Being in My World. In the second half of the term we will be looking at Celebrating Differences.

Over the first half term Year 1 and 2 will be starting pedal training led by an external agency.
