As READERS & WRITERS we will be:

Improving fluency reading, writing and speaking by using the Read Write in systematic approach to teaching literacy.

Children will be helped to develop from their starting point to progress through the scheme and become confident in all aspects of writing and reading including spelling and handwriting.

As well as this they will continue to hear a wide range of stories and authors' work to encourage them to become curious, enthusiastic readers.

As MATHEMATICIANS we will be:

First we are focusing on place value to 10 and beyond. We will be counting up to . We will use various strategies and equipment to become confident in simple calculation using the four operations. We will also be developing our 2x 5x 10x tables and applying this real life situations .

In RE we will be following the East Riding R.E. curriculum. The unit will be called Looking at me looking at you. We will recognise beliefs that are the same for different faiths and explore Meanings. **We will continue to** ask questions

As HISTORIANS we will be asking questions, thinking critically, explore and evaluating evidence and artefacts. We will look at the past using a range of resources. We will focusing on our selves through timelines, Family trees. We look at a local timeline and compare pastimes of the past and present .

As Artists we will be look a range of artists famous for portrait art. We will make a series of work in similar styles. We will ask questions, explore and describe art works as well think critically .We use a range of mediums.

In PSHCE we will be:

Following the Jigsaw Unit Being in My World. In the second half of the term we will be looking at Celebrating Differences.

British Values themes/links will be: Mutual respect and tolerance of those with different faiths

As MUSICIANS Year 1 will be listen, evaluate and perform music. For Year 1 our topic is called Hey You. These are from the Charanga music scheme. We will start to listen , respond and develop to a range of music

In PE we will be focusing on running through the unit called Locomotion. The children will learn flexibility, strength, technique, control and balance. They will develop balance, agility and coordination.

As SCIENTISTS we will be:

We will be learning about humans and animals. We will look at a range of areas such as senses, physical needs, hygiene and healthy eating. We will complete investigations that provide opportunities to develop scientific enquiry and skills. The children will investigate animals environment and why animals become pets. The children will have a range of opportunities such as visits from the school nurse, tasting and other cross curricula activities. The children make predications, they will classify and group objects/data as well as research secondary sources

In COMPUTING we will be:

using information technology to create non-fiction texts. The children will develop their skills in using software to organise images, text and formatting in their projects.
