As READERS we will be:

Clarifying new words, making predictions and summarising what we have read. We will also be asking and answering questions about our reading. We will continue to learn and apply our phonic knowledge.

As WRITERS we will be:

Acquiring new vocabulary and using this effectively in our writing, learning to spell words from the 1/2 word lists and building on the range of punctuation that we can use accurately. We will be doing this in a range of contexts.

As MATHEMATICIANS we will be:

Practising all four operations $+$ $-$ \times \div with a focus on multiplication and division. We will be studying money and using this to solve problems. Children will continue to learn how to tell the time including quarter and half past to and before the hour.

As DESIGNERS we will be:

Making our own Puppet. We will be using a range of sewing techniques as well as researching puppets. Using our puppets we will be creating piece of animations

Year 2 Spring Term

As SCIENTISTS we will be:

This 'Uses of Everyday Materials' unit will teach your class about the uses of everyday materials including wood, plastic, metal, glass, brick, paper and cardboard. Children then go on to compare the suitability of different everyday materials for different purposes. They explore how objects made of some everyday materials can change shape and how the recycling process is able to reuse some everyday materials numerous times. It finishes with children learning about new discoveries which have made over time with a specific focus on John McAdam. A range of learning activities are used in this unit including, discussions, debates, sequencing and a local walk where children work scientifically to identify the uses of everyday materials in the local area.

Using maps and atlases to support our research on London and the landmarks, tourism, trade etc./. We will also be looking at a range of landmarks in the United kingdom
