

Shall we find out about the past?

As READERS we will be:

Clarifying new words, making predictions and summarising what we have read. We will also be asking and answering questions about our reading. We will continue to learn and apply our phonic knowledge. We will be focusing more on the phonics screening at the end of Summer.

As WRITERS we will be:

Acquiring new vocabulary and using this effectively in our writing, learning to spell words from the 1/2 word lists and building on the range of punctuation that we can use accurately. We will be doing this in a range of contexts.

In our adventure stories unit we will be exploring how stories are structured. We will be exploring character development, sequence and the children will write their own stories based on adventures through time.

As MATHEMATICIANS we will be:

Focusing on addition and subtraction through different contexts. We will extend 1 digit add 1 digit to 2 digit add 1 digit. We will do this through various strategies. We will also be developing our 2x 5x 10x tables and applying it into real life situations.

Year 2 Summer Term



As HISTORIANS we will be:

Researching historical facts about the past using a range of resources. We will be looking at famous historians of flight as well as studying key points in the British timeline.

As DESIGNERS we will be: researching, designing and making our own time machines!! . These will have moving parts.

In PE we will be: team games linked to sports day.

In RE Year 1 will be looking at places of worship and festivals.

Year 2 will be doing the unit called questions, questions. Key stage 1 will also be visiting the church for a pretend Baptism.

In PSHCE we will be:

Developing our growth mindset ethos.

Over the summer term Year 2 children will be doing the statutory tests. Year 1 children will also be doing the national phonics screening tests.

SRE
