Year 3 Autumn Term



As READERS we will be:

Improving our reading fluency using the Read Write Inc. scheme. We will also be exploring books together to improve our reading comprehension skills. Our class read is 'Alone in his Teacher's House' by Louis Sachar.

As WRITERS we will be:

Extending our vocabulary and how to use this effectively in our writing. We will be working on new spelling rules and practising year 3 spellings. Finally, we will guild our grammatical skills writing a range of texts for different purposes.

As MATHEMATICIANS we will be:

We will be working on place value, addition and subtraction. We will extend our numbers into the 100s and improve our fluency in times tables 10, 5, 2, and 3.

As SCIENTISTS we will be:

Exploring and learning all about plants. Looking at what each parts does and what they need to grow. This will involve us using different investigational skills to make predictions and observations of fair test we setup within the classroom. We will be harvesting crops that we sowed in year 2.

In PSHE we will be:

We use the Jigsaw curriculum to find out more about 'Being me in my world'

As GEOGRAPHERS we will be:

Exploring Hull and the UK. We will be looking at the significance of the Humber ports and estuary. We will investigate how the topography of the East Riding of Yorkshire influences trade, settlements and flood defences.

As HISTORIANS we will be:

undertaking work in this subject as part of our next unit in Autumn 2

As DESIGNERS we will be:

undertaking work in this subject as part of our next unit in Autumn 2

In PE we will be:

We will further develop our individual & team skills playing Invasion Games. This will help build our strength and techniques.

As MUSICIANS we will be:

Developing performance and instrument playing skills using the song Let your Spirits Fly. Looking at how we can change tempo and pitch within a piece of music when composing or playing songs.

As LINGUISTS we will be:

Learning how to greet someone new we are meeting. We will learn simple conversation such as 'Hello' and 'How are you?' After, we will start to explore words for our family members and counting in French.

As ARTISTS we will be:

Creating portraits for our exhibition 'Hull Ambassadors' after developing our drawing skills. We will study portraits by artists from different times and movements including Holbein, Picasso and Chagall.

In RE we will be:

Exploring two different religious celebration and comparing what is similar and different in each celebration. Concentrating on why, how, where and what they do to celebrate.

In COMPUTING we will be:

Developing skills using core programs. As always, teaching e-safety will be a key priority.
