As READERS we will be:

Exploring new vocabulary in a range of contexts, making predictions and summarising what we have read. We will also be working on our comprehension and inference skills.

As WRITERS we will be:

Extending our knowledge of writing for different purposes. Also, learning new spelling rules and practising year 3/4 spellings.

We will be building our knowledge of new year 4 grammar including conjunctions, adverbs and prepositions to express time and cause.

As MATHEMATICIANS we will be:

Learning the 7, 9 and 12 times table multiplication and division facts. We will also be building on previous knowledge of fractions and decimals.

As SCIENTISTS we will be:

Recognising how sounds are made and how they travel to the ear. We will also be making musical instruments and explaining how they work.

As HISTORIANS we will be:

Exploring the Stone Age. This will involve us investigating their everyday life including their food, homes and religion. We will discover how they developed tools and farming from the Stone age through to the Iron age..

As DESIGNERS we will:

Designing and making tools and weapons from the different eras. Also exploring how housing developed.

In PE we will be:

Developing asemantic and semantic shapes in gymnastics .

In PSHCE we will be:

Thinking about things that have challenged them in the past and creating goals and challenges that they would like to complete.

As GEOGRAPHERS we will be:

Learning about continental drift and exploring the reasons why the first humans settled in Britain.

As ARTISTS we will be:

Exploring Stone Age cave paintings and learning about how they were created. This will help us to develop our painting skills.

As MUSICIANS we will be:

Developing performance and singing skills.
