Year 3 Spring Term



As READERS we will be:

Clarifying new words, making predictions and summarising what we have read. We will also be asking and answering questions about our reading.

As WRITERS we will be:

Learning new vocabulary and how to use this effectively in our writing, learning to spell words from the 3/4 word lists and building on the range of punctuation that we can use accurately. We will be doing this in a range of contexts.

As MATHEMATICIANS we will be:

Learning how to multiply and divide using the 3,4 and 8 times table and using this knowledge to times and divide 2 digit number. We will also learn about adding and subtracting money and using graphs and charts to record findings.

As SCIENTISTS we will be:

Exploring how plants grow, what they need to grow and their life cycle. This will include learning new subject specific vocabulary and developing our skills in planning and carrying out investigations and collecting and analysing data.

As GEOGRAPHERS we will be:

Exploring the UK, looking at different location and why they are there. This will include looking at urban areas, rural areas, docks, national parks and costal areas. We will use atlas and maps to help us lactate these areas and then explore there key features.

As DESIGNERS we will:

Designing healthy, balanced meals from different cuisines around the world using food we have grown. We will be evaluating these and suggesting improvements.

In PE we will be:

Exploring and performing different dances from the UK and all around the world. In Spring 2 we will further develop our individual and team skills playing Invasion Games.

In PSHCE we will be:

Reflecting on our personal abilities, qualities and strengths and using this to set goals for 2019.

As HISTORIANS we will be:

Developing our understanding of how the UK has changed over a period of time and suggesting some of the reasons for these changes.

As ARTISTS we will be:

Focusing on developing our skills of drawing and painting. We will explore Hundertwasser's art and try and recreate our own versions.

As MUSICIANS we will be:

Musical theatre based on dances and songs from Shrek

As LINGUISTS we will be:

Learning how to say and write basic greets and basic information about ourselves

In RE we will be:

Discussing 'Faith founder'. Children will explore who created different religions and the story behind these people.

In COMPUTING we will be:

Learning how to use basic computer programs to record information.
