

As READERS & WRITERS we will be:

Improving fluency reading, writing and speaking by using the Read Write in systematic approach to teaching literacy.

Children will be helped to develop from their starting point to progress through the scheme and become confident in all aspects of writing and reading including spelling and handwriting.

As well as this they will continue to hear a wide range of stories and authors' work to encourage them to become curious, enthusiastic readers.

As MATHEMATICIANS we will be:

Looking at developing our addition and subtractions skills. We will use these into real life situations. We will also be developing our understanding of 2d and 3d shapes. We will be using a varied range of vocabulary.

We will also be developing our 2x 5x 10x tables and applying this to real life situations.

In RE we will be following the East Riding R.E. curriculum. The unit will be called Looking at me looking at you. We will recognise beliefs that are the same for different faiths and explore Meanings. **We will continue to ask questions**

Where I live Autumn 2 Year 1



As studiers of Geography we will be developing an understanding of the world around us. We will be focusing on the countries and cities that make up the United Kingdom. We will develop our understanding of where we live. We will investigate our capital cities, landmarks including human and natural features. We look at why Hull is where it is in the country.

In PSHCE we will be:

Following the Jigsaw Unit looking at Celebrating Differences.

As Designers we will become bakers. We will investigate and research a range of foods and focus on bread. We will look at different types of bread and from around the world. Using this research we will design our own bread and different ingredients. We will then bake and evaluate our product.

As MUSICIANS Year 1 will be listening, evaluating and performing music. For Year 1 our topic is called Rhythm in the Way We Walk & Banana Rap. These are from the Charanga music scheme. We will start to listen, respond and develop to a range of music.

In PE we will be focusing on running through the unit called Self Belief Dance - 'The Zoo' - we will have a specialist dancing instructor to teach us.

As SCIENTISTS we will be:

Focusing on animals. We discover the differences between different animals and which animals make good pets. We will be looking at the needs of animals in the wild and the needs of animals as pets. We will investigate our own school grounds. We will research facts about animals. We will ask questions and collect data.

In COMPUTING we will be:

using information technology to create non-fiction texts. The children will develop their skills in using software to organise images, text and formatting in their projects.
